Concert Attire

All Beginning and Intermediate music students at Kinard wear the same style uniform: Kinard Shirt (specific shirt TBD) Black from the Waist - Down

We use the same uniform for all 6th & 7th grade ensembles at Kinard, so siblings can use the same outfit from other years/ensembles. Thanks to the Kinard Contribution Drive, the costs of the Kinard Music Shirt is covered.

Grades & Assignments

1) Rehearsal & Performance Assessments:

Students will earn a series of performance grades based on their work during class, participation in class performance, and demonstration of the knowledge/skills being learned.

2) Concerts & Performances:

A concert is the 'final' for the class, so there is a grade associated with participation in the concert, <u>including lis-</u> tening to other performing groups.

3) Homework & Home Performance:

Students will learn how to use their laptops as a tool for rehearsing, recording, and uploading their singing. We use Google Classroom as a platform for home-to-school learning

4) Quizzes & Music Assessments:

Online assessments are administered to get a feel for your child's knowledge in music theory and music history aligned to the Core Knowledge Sequence

5) Late Work

Obviously, we expect all homework to be turned in on time. If you anticipate turning in an assignment late, PLEASE let me know so we can make arrangements

Missing a Concert

Concerts are a significant part of the choral experience at Kinard. Students are expected to attend each concert as part of their final grade. Of course, things happen. If you cannot attend a concert, please let Mr. Wheeler know, in writing, *as soon as possible*! Students who miss a concert can make it up by digitally recording a solo performance, which I will listen to and assess for their concert grade.

Core Knowledge

Students who participate in choir are not only singing, but also learning how music works and its place in our society. Because music is an academic part of the Core Knowledge Sequence, students will be learning music theory, history, and listening concepts throughout the school year.
